BOHANON FAMILY PAPERS

The papers are largely financial records of a succession of Bohanon males. The earliest person mentioned is Jonathan Bohanan, who died in 1847. John Bohanan, his son, who lived from 1811-1871, generated the bulk of the papers. Of particular interest are records of the enlistment of two slaves in the Union Army and the paper trail of Mr. Bohanan's attempt to get compensation for the loss of the two men. Members of the Benson, Courtney, Sanner, Milburn, and Hilton families appear in the papers as well. [**1966.001+** This collection is completely described.
