The Adams lived on Saint George Island. “Rex” Adams’ family ran a hotel on the island. “Fess” Albright’s family bought a large tract of land in the southern county that Mr. Albright tried to develop as Andover. The young people married in 1923, moved to Washington to work in 1934, and retired to the island in 1963. They enlarged the Adams’ family home and had a busy social life. Mrs. Adams died in 1991 and Mr. Adams in 1994. Many of the things in this collection have to do with the Albrights, but there is also material about boundary disputes on Saint George Island.
