

PAPERS OF THE MISSES HEBB

Mary, Ruth, and Elizabeth Hebb were born in Saint Mary's County. The papers in this collection have information about the Hebb family and some information the sisters' school for young ladies in Wilmington, Del. There are 21 diaries, but the entries in most are not comprehensive. The bulk of the material is the records and correspondence of Jean Kane Foulke DuPont, a former student, who assumed responsibility for the welfare of the two remaining sisters in the 1930s. There are financial records about the maintenance of the ladies, correspondence with former students and distant relatives, and all the paperwork associated with the disposition of the ladies' personal effects. Mrs. DuPont did some genealogical research about the Hebb family and about the Kanes and Foulkes, her own family. [1958.001+ There are series records for the Hebb material.]
